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Happy 2015 MAMMI first New Year's newsletter!



Progress to Date (December 2014)

The number of women who have completed each stage of the study is as follows:

Survey 1 (early pregnancy)	1833
Survey 2 (3 months postpartum)	1199
Survey 3 (6 months postpartum)	991
Survey 4 (9 months postpartum)	817
Survey 5 (12 months postpartum)	623

The response rate of the different surveys along the months is as follows:



Later surveys come in as women continue in the study. We love getting your postnatal surveys as they tell us how you are getting on in your life as a new mother.

MAMMI Study starting up in new site in February

Recruitment for the MAMMI study at the Rotunda has finally come to an end after almost 3 years however the exciting news is that we have been approved to bring the MAMMI study to a third study site: the Coombe Women's and Infants University Hospital (CWIUH) where recruitment will start around February/March. MAMMI study in Galway is still going on and very well with great response rate.
